

London facing public worker recruitment crisis - union

A union says London could face a huge recruitment crisis unless the pay of public service workers is boosted.

Unison says health workers, council staff and other public sector employees are being priced out of London.

Industrial action is being threatened over the union campaign to increase the London Weighting allowance.

Unison's general secretary Dave Prentis says: "The delivery of quality public services in our capital is at risk because of low pay and high living costs."
